Return with one click, stay home and stay safe

AEA allows the public to return payment certificates online

In order to make the public feel safe and stay at home during the epidemic, AEA provides the services that allowing the public to return the electronic files or pictures of their payment certificates of overdue tax payment, arrears and fines to the email of each branch from June 8, 2021, and a personnel designated for the service will be in charge of relevant matters, such as write-offs.

In response to the CECC's announcement that nationwide Level 3 epidemic alert has been extended to June 28, the report date on the payment notification for the case other than the cases violating the epidemic prevention regulations has been extended. In addition, in order to prevent the public from going out to fax or send the payment certificate and increasing the risk of movement and gathering, AEA instructed its 13 branches to provide specific email addresses for the public to return their payment certificates. AEA also provides a specific link on the official website of each branch, the public may return their names, case numbers to the branch online with clear pictures or electronic files of payment certificates via the link, and a personnel designated for the business will help to process the cases, so the public may close their cases at home.

AEA reminds the public that if they have any questions or have financial difficulties to pay the payment in a lump-sum payment, they can contact the person in charge with the

phone number indicated on the payment notification or writ of execution for assistance to reduce the risk of being infected when going out.
