Before the Moon Festival, the total amount made from the highest-bidding of the joint auctions held on the “first” “Tuesday” of every month, starting at “3” p.m. has exceeded NT 70 million dollars.

The joint auction held on the “first” “Tuesday” of every month, starting at “3” p.m. held by the branches before the holidays of the Moon Festival (September 6) has been popular, and the public is enthusiastic about the auction and competes for bids actively. The total amount made from the auction has reached NTD 70,972,547, showing the implementation of the public power and bringing income to the treasury.

For real estate properties, the total amount made from the highest bid was NTD 67,122,028. The most eye-catching real estate property is the "Imperial Seal" residence located on the 24th floor of Zhongzheng Road, Taoyuan District, Taoyuan City and auctioned by Taoyuan Branch. It is close to Taoyuan Station and is in good condition. The public won the auction with the highest-bidding of NTD 28,669,000, which exceeded the upset price by more than NTD 4,630,000. Taoyuan Branch also auctioned 6 lands in Longshan Section, Taoyuan District, Taoyuan City for NTD 4,597,054; Taichung Branch auctioned a house located at the Shengli 12th Street, Tanzi District, Taichung City for NTD 14,379,999; New Taipei Branch auctioned off a family cemetery located at Xiaonanwan Section, Linkou District, New

Taipei City for NTD 4,736,000; Tainan Branch auctioned a land located at Guangming Section, East District, Tainan City for NTD 3,433,000; Kaohsiung Branch auctioned a land and a building located at Zhonghua Section, Sanmin District, Kaohsiung City for NTD 688,888; Pingtung Branch auctioned two lands located at Xinrong section of Chaozhou Township, Pingtung County for NTD 660,000; Hualien Branch auctioned the land located at Jinxing Section of Taimari Township in Taitung County for \$636,800; Yilan Branch auctioned the land located at Ronghua section of Zhongshan District in Keelung City for NTD 1,688,889; and other branches also auctioned a number of high-quality real estate properties, allowing the public to purchase real estate properties at affordable prices for both investment and personal use.

The total amount made from the highest-bidding of personal properties was NTD 3,850,519. The most eye-catching and highest-bidding item was an IVECO camping car auctioned by Kaohsiung Branch for NTD 1,100,000 after fierce bidding on-site. Shilin Branch auctioned a Lexus automobile for NTD 280,000; New Taipei Branch auctioned a minivan for NTD 220,000; Taoyuan Branch auctioned a BMW automobile for \$132,000. There were also various stocks auctioned by the branches, including Sunny Bank, COTA Commercial Bank, Bank of Panhsin, Taisun Enterprise, and Pacific Electric Wire and Cable Co., Ltd., all of them have been successfully sold. The rest of the auctioned personal properties include: Kolin robot vacuum cleaners, water repellent and warming gloves with e-touch function, stone seals, fortune trees, salt lamps, red dragon ornaments, jade artworks, jewelry, jade ornaments, aboriginal handmade goods, accessories for cell phones and 3C devices, watches from various brands, hotel towels, teas, handmade soaps and other quality items. The public actively participated in the bidding for the above-mentioned items.

AEA reminds the public that, during the holidays, the local epidemic of COVID-19 is still ongoing, the public can make use of the communication bidding to participate in real estate auctions and avoid the risks from the epidemic; the public participating in the on-site bidding of personal properties at each branch should strictly comply with all the epidemic prevention regulations, wear masks throughout the process and take proper personal epidemic prevention measures to protect the health of the citizens.
